Poster Guidelines

General Information

- Your poster is part of a poster visit session.
- During the poster visit sessions you are required to remain by your poster and share your research with other attendees.
- Each poster visit session will last 25 minutes.
- For each topic, there will be a poster discussion after the corresponding lecture session. The presenter of the poster discussion may contact you in advance to gather information about your poster and incorporate it into the poster discussion.

Setup of the Posters

- Please put up your poster in the designated poster area for your topic on Friday, January 26th, until 12 pm
- Locate your space by searching for the board with your Poster ID.
- Materials (e.g., pins, tape) to tag your poster to the boards will be provided on site.
- Posters should remain on display until 1 pm on January 27th, 2024.
- Posters not removed after the conclusion of the conference will be discarded.

Formal Guidelines

- Posters should be printed in A0 format (width x height in mm: 841 x 1189).
- Posters should be created in portrait format (not landscape).
- There are no specific format requirements in terms of font size, font style, and number of characters. However, we recommend keeping accessibility in mind when designing your poster.
- The structure of a poster usually follows that of an oral scientific presentation and includes introduction, background, methods, results, and conclusions. However, this may also vary depending on the content.
- No audiovisual equipment is permitted for poster presentations.
